VISION: Army Families with strong parenting and relationship skills that enable them to cope with the stresses of military life in a healthy manner.

The Family Advocacy Program is committed to the strong Army Families, and the prevention and treatment of Family violence. Its coordinated efforts are designed to prevent and intervene in cases of Family distress, and to promote healthy Family life.

The Army Family Advocacy Program coordinates and provides numerous programs, services and activities that support our Families, enhance their relationship skills, and improve their quality of life.

The Family Advocacy Program is a vigorous, proactive outreach program of training, education and services that enhance communication, parenting skills, stress management and quality of life.

FAP builds awareness that every couple faces challenges, that these challenges are private and personal, and that they do not have to be faced alone.

The well being of Army soldiers and their Families is inextricably linked to our Army's readiness. The Family Advocacy Program contributes to force readiness and mission accomplishment by providing a resource for commanders and Families in preventing and solving Family problems.

FAP supports soldiers and Families in managing personal and Family problems with the goal of preventing domestic violence. For soldiers involved in Family violence, early referral reduces risk, establishes safety limits, and provides treatment for victims and offenders.
