RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE OSJA

Who are you going to call? Most people know to call the Staff Judge Advocate's Office when they have legal questions, but many do not know what section to call. In order to save time in having your call re-directed, please take a few minutes to read over what each section does and how to contact them.

The Offices of the Staff Judge Advocate and the Trial Defense Service are located on the second floor of Building 218 on Torii Station, across the street from the post office.

Legal Assistance (Room 220): In addition to doing wills, powers of attorney, and notaries (walk-in service), we provide legal advice on any personal, legal issues, except military criminal offenses and most military administrative separations (Trial Defense). We do not advise commanders or supervisors (Trial Counsel or Administrative Law attorneys). Army regulations forbid us from giving employment law advice, business advice, or advice on claims against the United States Government. For a legal assistance appointment call 644-4332.

Tax Assistance (Room 221): During tax season (1 February to 15 June), you can call 644-1040 for a tax appointment at Torii Station. We also have a joint tax center at Kadena: 634-7418.

Military Justice (Room 237): Commanders or supervisors who need legal advice on what action to take on a military justice matter, or need advice on what legal obligations they have to a Soldier, should contact Military Justice at 644-5195.

Claims (Room 222) If you want to file a claim for damage to your private property that resulted from a PCS or other government sponsored move, or was caused by a natural disaster (such as a typhoon), fire, flood, theft, or vandalism, or was due to the fault or negligence of Army activities, you should contact the claims office. Please contact claims office at 644-4742.

International Law and Off-Duty Employment (Room 238) If you are involved in a Japanese criminal investigation or traffic incident and need information on Japanese law and procedures or you need a memorandum to verify you have status under the US-Japan Status of Forces Agreement or you need to obtain approval to engage in off-duty employment or private commercial activities, then international law can provide you this information and assistance. Please contact the international law office at 644-4782.

Labor Law (Room 240) Commanders or supervisors who want legal advice concerning Army civilian personnel issues can contact the labor counselor at 644-4783. The labor law counselor is restricted to advising management officials and cannot represent or give advice to individual employees concerning their personal employment situation.
